1. Create a video resume and upload it as a YouTube link. See below for details.
2. Save a copy of your official transcript as a PDF file.
3. Request a letter of recommendation from your current grade 12 World Language teacher, that includes information about your overall qualifications, interest in the language, and academic performance in your Grade 12 language class.

Your video resume should sell yourself to the committee – it's really a commercial about you! It should answer the question:

Why should we award this scholarship to you?

What should you include in this video resume?

- It should be creative, interesting, and preferably in the target language!
- Since we are an organization dedicated to the promotion of the study and teaching of world languages, explain why are languages important to you
- What impact have they had on your life?
- What impact will you have on the world?
- What are your future plans? College? Which one? Why? How do you plan to use the language(s) you have studied?
- Have you used your study of world languages in your community? If so, how?
